Enchanted Forest



CURRICULUM DAY

Storytelling that connects children with nature and helps them begin to understand the basic systems of the woodland. Enjoy making nature crafts, using natural materials to make nature crowns and journey sticks. The day is also filled with lots of nature play based fun.
